Please join us in welcoming Amanda Lewis as our new District Executive!

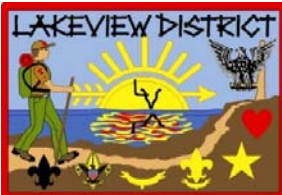
Here is some information to help you get to know her:
